WHAT'S IN BLOOM: All three Desert Willow trees (Chilopsis linearis) and recently transplanted Red Bird of Paradise (Caesalpinia pulcherrima), seen here in the western water retention basin photo.

Look for the small perennial Angelica Daisy with yellow flowers as well as several yellow wildflowers in the basin areas that are fall flowering members of the Aster Family (Asteraceae).
